

Education Program Exit Criteria

Upon exiting the Washington and Jefferson College Education program students will have:

- 1) Applied for admission and received acceptance into the teacher certification program from the Committee on the Teaching Profession (COTP) during the student's sophomore year.
- 2) Applied for acceptance to student teach from the Committee on the Teaching Profession in the junior year.
- 3) Completed all content area tests prior to student teaching.
- 4) Successfully completed a 12 week student teaching semester senior year.
- 5) Achieved a satisfactory rating on the PA statewide evaluation form for student professional knowledge and practice.
- 6) Maintained a 3.0 or above GPA meeting the requirement to receive certification in the state of Pennsylvania.
- 7) Met Washington and Jefferson College graduation requirements.
- 8) Received final recommendation for teacher certification by the Committee on the Teaching Profession.
- 9) Completed the Teacher Information Management System (TIMS) application for teacher certification.
- 10) Read and agreed to abide by the Code of Professional Practice and Conduct for Educators.
